

PEEL TOWN CENTRE REGENERATION

- Create new public spaces that may be used for entertainment, leisure or markets.
- Focus on pedestrians and not vehicles.
- Focus on other means of transport such as cycling and buses.
- Make the town centre accessible for all by having no raised kerbs, less obstructions and clear signs.
- Create a clear identity or style and flavour to the town centre that is uniquely Peel.
- Improve the street lighting by providing varied street lighting from wall lights to recessed lights in the ground.
- Reduce the number of signs in town by having a better signing strategy.
- Introduce new trees into the town centre.
- Provide more seating in public areas so people can spend time in the town centre and rest a while.
- Provide more shelter in selected public areas with new glass shelters.
- Provide opportunities where cafes and other businesses can expand onto the pavements.
- Create new public spaces outside key buildings such as St Peter's Church, Centenary Centre, the Leece Museum/Library and the Café/Kiosk on the Promenade.
- Provide opportunities for permanent public art work.
- Improve public facilities by having new toilets and an interactive public information kiosk.
