# Peel Town Commissioners Rates Budget for 2011/2012

The Commissioners have agreed to set the rate for 2011/12 at 237 pence which represents a 0.85% increase. The separate refuse charge for costs of incineration, refuse collection and the Town's contribution to the Western Civic Amenity Site remains unchanged at £126.50 per dwelling.

Continued investment in the Town's street lighting will be made and the landslip on the embankment at the rear of the Creg Malin will be reinstated. The Commissioners will also provide outdoor adult fitness equipment and the public conveniences at the Bowling Green Cafe will be upgraded and made more disabled friendly.
