## Peel Town Commissioners Rates Budget for 2013/2014

The Commissioners budget plans for 2013/2014 were severely compromised by the Department of Infrastructure's much publicised statement to withdraw its waste disposal subsidy from all local authorities.

To cover the additional £42,000 cost the separate refuse charge for incineration, refuse collection and the Town's contribution to the Western Civic Amenity Site will increase from £128.50 to to £152 per dwelling.

The town rate will remain at 242 pence in the pounds
