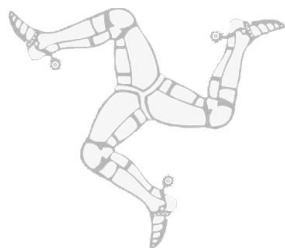

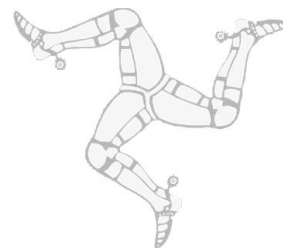

Spectator Safety Advice:

The following are some general spectator safety advice points issued by the Event Safety Officer to Spectators for this event:

Watching a live motor sport event is a thrilling experience and one of the best ways for fans to get close to the action, experiencing the sport's sights, sounds and smells first-hand.

The event organisers strive to keep spectators safe but ultimately all spectators are responsible for their own personal safety.

Here are some tips that spectators should remember at live events:

- ❖ Always keep your own safety and that of others in mind
- ❖ Park in a safe place
- ❖ ***Follow marshals' instructions - the marshals are there to help you and ensure that the event runs safely – please listen to their instructions and advice***
- ❖ Observe and obey all event signs
- ❖ Stay within the official spectator areas
- ❖ Do not enter any prohibited or restricted areas
- ❖ Keep off the road - please ensure that you do **NOT** walk on any special stage – remember that the event is run under the Road Races Act and as such you would be breaking the law in doing so
- ❖ Listen to official announcements
- ❖ Expect the unexpected
- ❖ Listen to what the marshals say - marshals and officials have the right to undertake their duties without being abused or threatened
- ❖ Abusive, threatening or violent behaviour towards officials (who are all volunteers) will not be tolerated and spectators will be evicted from the event
- ❖ Children and infants should ALWAYS be accompanied by an adequate number of adults who remain responsible for their behaviour
- ❖ Please be aware that the weather at the time of the event can be wet and extremely cold especially for the early morning and late afternoon/evening stages. Please make sure that you dress accordingly
- ❖ Take all litter home with you
- ❖ Please do not bring alcohol

On rallies, remember:

Cars may run wide on corners
Cars may cut corners
Cars may throw up stones
Cars may overshoot junctions
Cars may leave the road.

So, have fun but keep safe!

Assisting Cars: This has been a tradition in rallying but one that can unnecessarily place individuals or small groups of spectators (with or without marshals) at risk. Another car can easily leave the stage at the same point and very often, other competing cars are still continuing to pass on the stage. Where this practice can be avoided it should be.

Despite the organisers taking all reasonable precautions unavoidable accidents can happen in respect to these you are present at your own risk

The warning signage detailed within this document will be placed at any means of spectator or vehicular access to a Rally Special Stage where the event officials deem appropriate. e.g. public footpaths, green ways and/or road junctions. Please make yourself familiar with the information stated within.

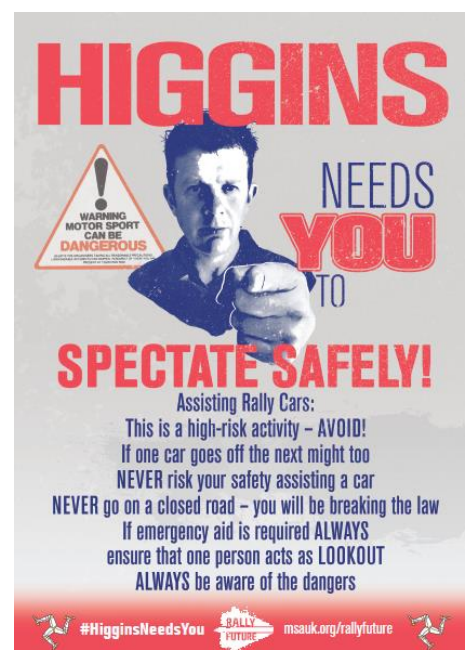
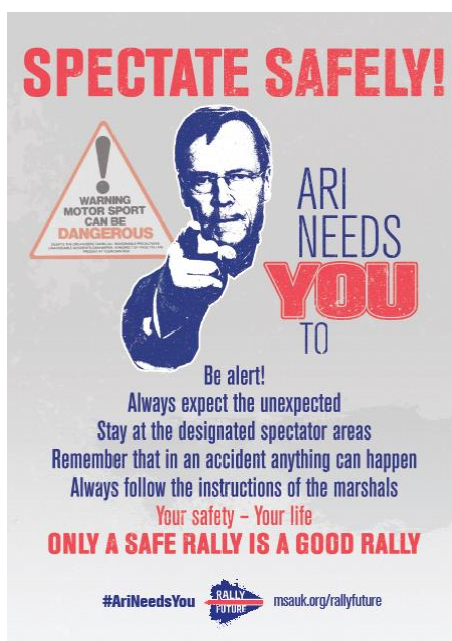

Where this happens, a rally marshal has authority to notify the stage commander that the stage may have to be delayed and the stage commander will immediately take the appropriate action which may include stopping the stage"

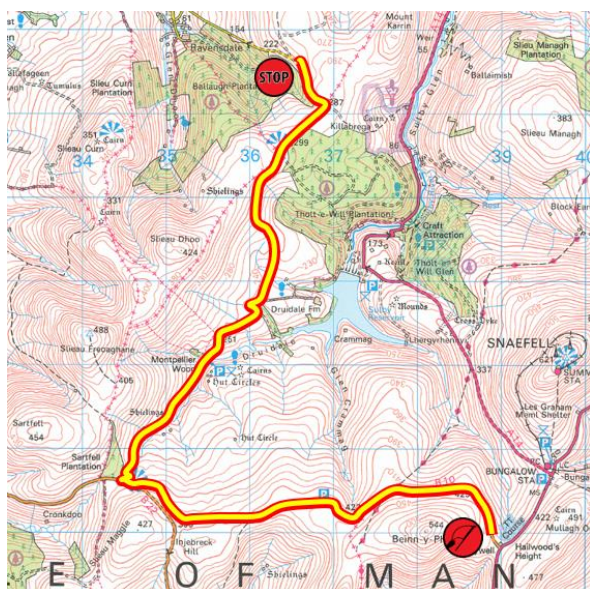
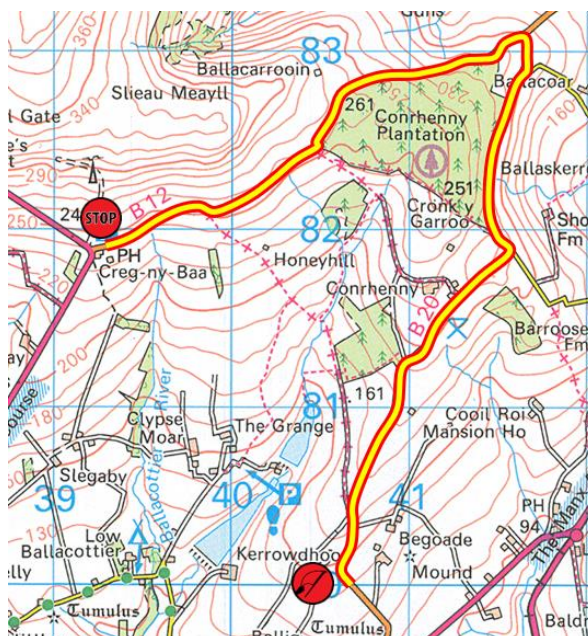
Special Stage Overview:

Shakedown – Creg-ny-Baa

Road Closing Times:

Friday 11th May 2018 – 10:00 until 14:30

This exciting stage starting just off the top of the Whitebridge Road; through the Dog Kennel triangle and onward towards the five and a half corner following the perimeter of the Conrheny Plantation; finishing just before Creg-ny-Baa.



Special Stage 1/5 – Druidale

Friday 11th May 2018 17:30 until 00:05

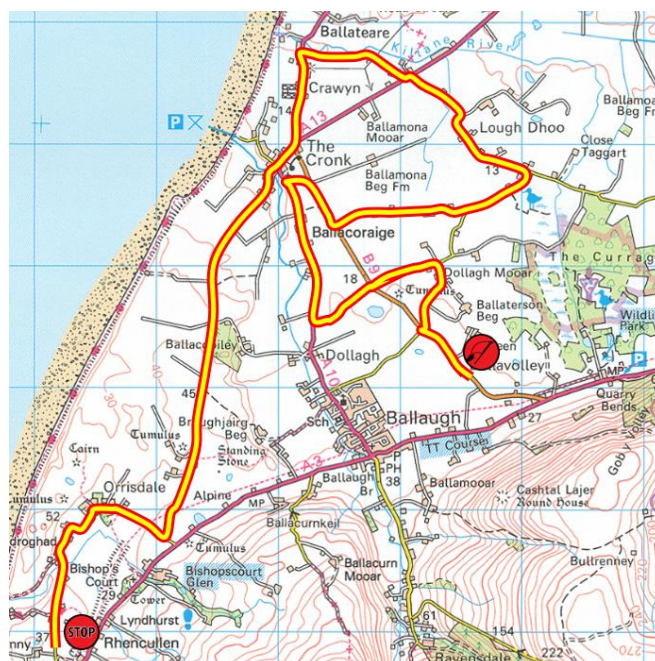
The famous Druidale stage starting on the Brandywell Road down through a fast and tricky section to Brandywell Cottage then hairpin right heading over the famous Druidale section towards the finish overlooking Ballaugh Plantation.

Special Stage 2/6 – The Cronk

Road Closing Times:

Friday 11th May 2018 18:00 until 00:20

A challenging stage starting on the Ballacrye Road before heading through the tight and tricky sections of the Ballaterson and Dollagh Roads before heading through the Ballaugh Loop Road onward towards the Old Windmill Road, Castle Lake and Kilane Road. Heading back towards the Cronk, down the Bollyn Road, through the Orrisdale Loop to the finish.



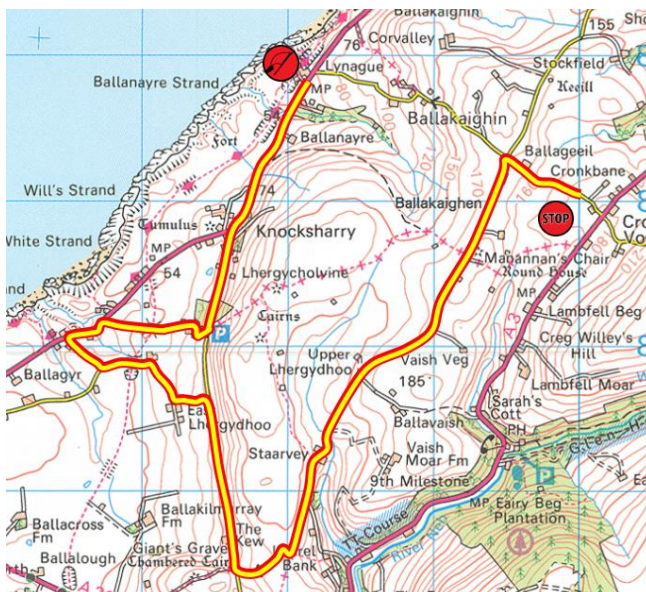
Special Stage Overview:

Special Stage 3/7 Staarvey

Road Closing Times:

Friday 11th May 2018 18:30 until 00:45

A very fast and challenging stage starting near Lynague on the West Coast on the A4 Peel to Kirk Michael Road through Knocksharry then onward to the East Lhergydhoo, then the Switchback and Staarvey made infamous by the Ari Vatanen escort crash onward to the Stockfield Crossroads before finishing just before the Cronk-y-Voddy Crossroads

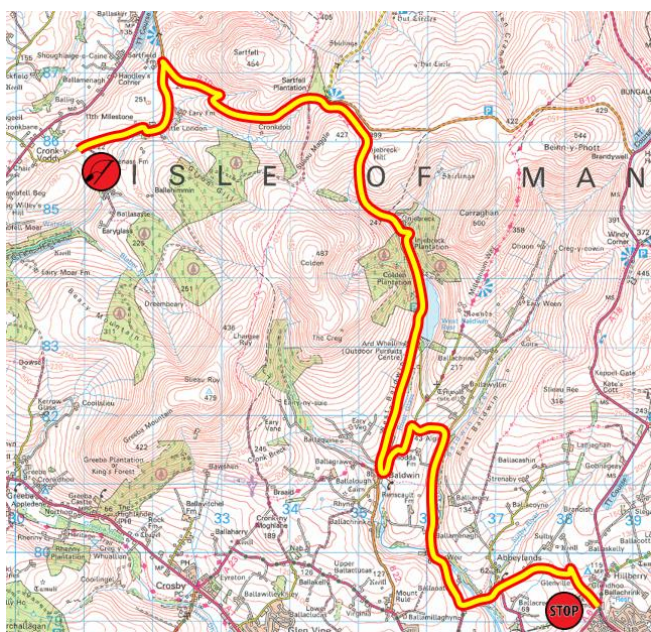


Special Stage 4/8 - The Baldwin

Road Closing Times:

Friday 11th May 2018 18:40 until 01:30

A demanding and challenging classic starting on the famous Little London section onwards towards Brandywell Cottage turning onto Injebreck Hill, through the tricky section over Injebreck, past Reservoir House. Heading through Baldwin village, the stage takes you up through Algare, then down through East Baldwin to Ballaoates and onwards over the famous Abbeylands Crossroads finishing at Cronk-ny-Mona.



Special Stage 9/10 - Keristal

Road Closing Times:

Saturday 12th May 2018 09:20 until 13:40

A fast-flowing stage starting beyond Keristal, through Port Soderick up under the railway bridge, onto the Old Castletown Road, finishing at the Blackboards.



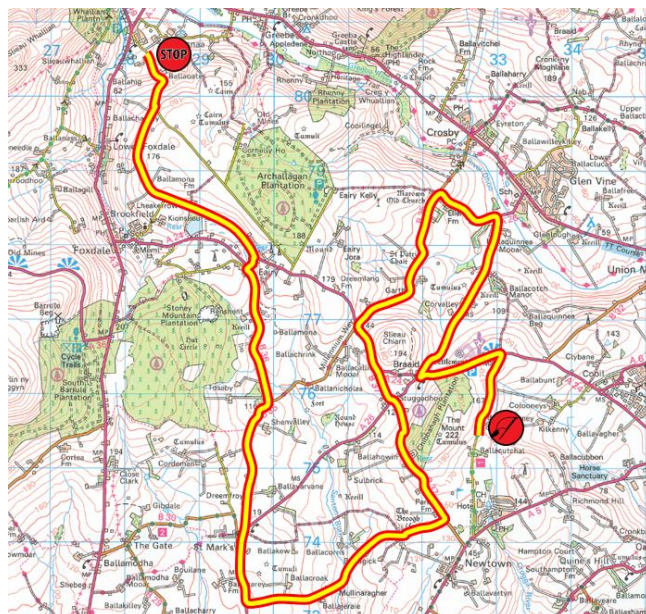
Special Stage Overview (cont.):

Special Stage 12/16 - St Marks

Road Closing Times:

Saturday 12th May 2018 10:00 to 16:30

A challenging stage starting on the Mount Murray Back Road down to the Braaid Crossroads heading on to Ellislie Farm, the Garth Old Church Road onwards towards the Garth Crossroads. Through the Red Lion Crossroads up and over the Clannagh Road down through Mullinaragher. Out through St Marks Village to Tosaby heading towards the Eairy Dam, Lhoobs Road to the finish before the Hope.



Special Stage 11/15 - Round Table

Road Closing Times:

Saturday 12th May 2018 10:50 to 17:00

A fast but challenging stage starting on Slieau Whallian up through the old Glen Rushen Mines, onwards to the Round Table Crossroads. Down to Ronague Hairpin along the Corlea Road and dropping down to Grenaby Bridge. Off towards Ballabeg Hairpin back up to Ronague before heading down Ballagawne towards the finish at Parville

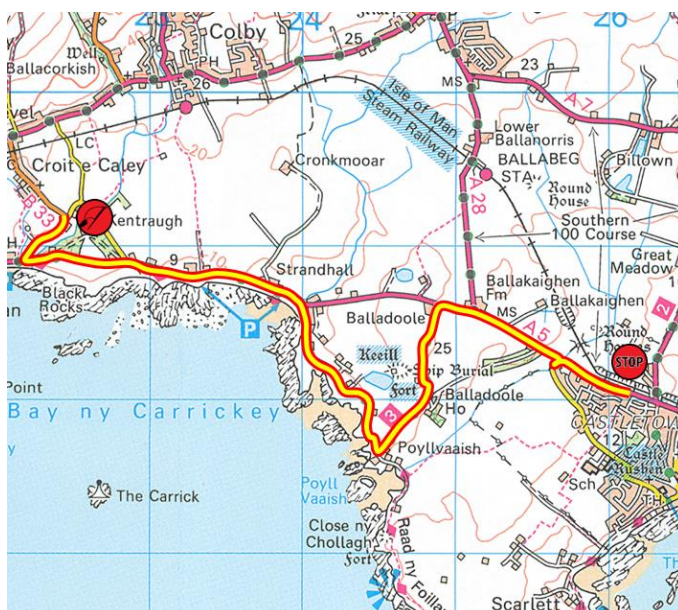


Special Stages 13/14 Balladoole

Road Closing Times:

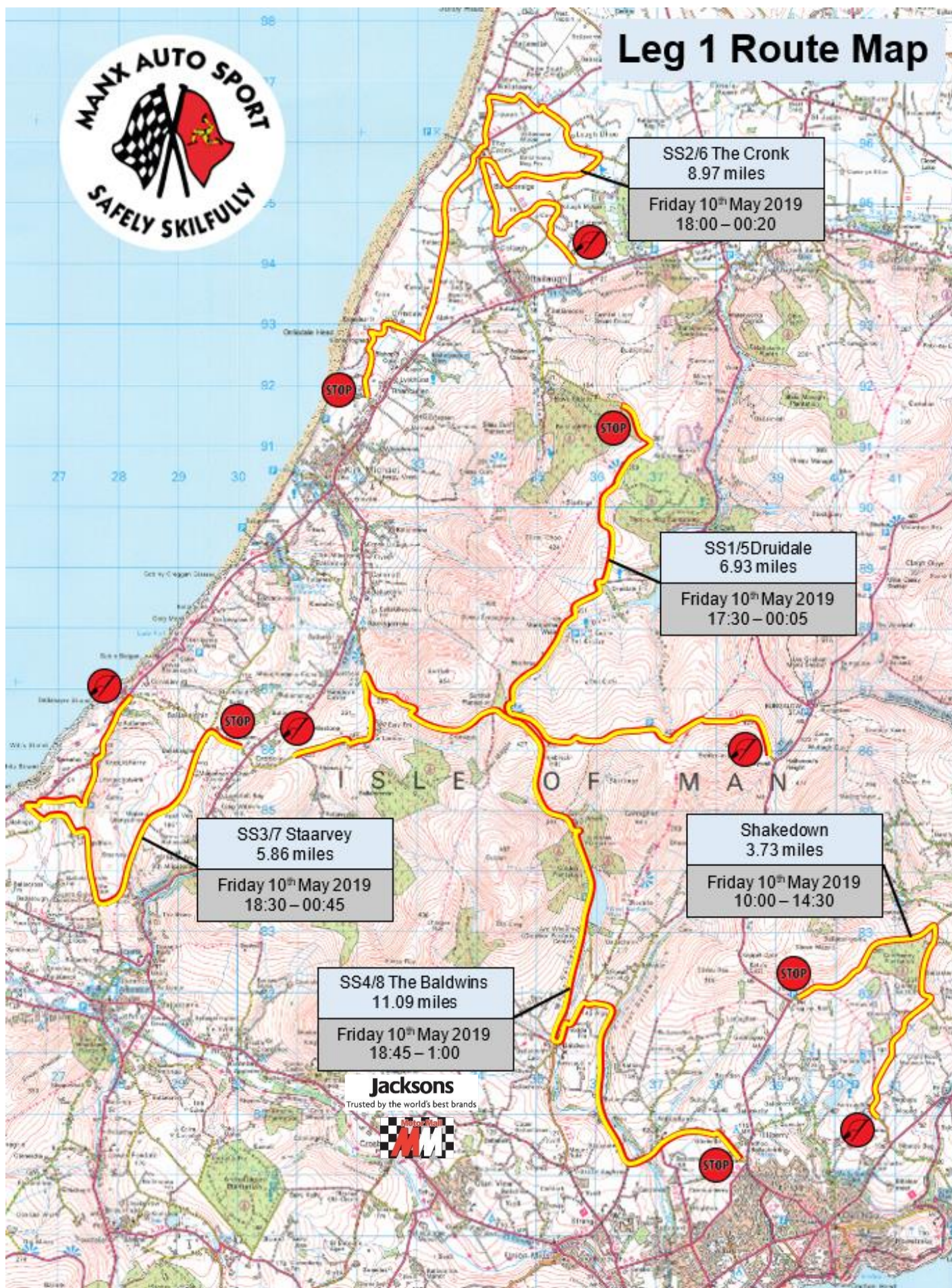
Saturday 12th May 2018 11:10 until 15:30
